Seattle-Based Trans Marine Propulsion Systems, Inc. Will Open Subsidiary in Tampa, Florida



Seattle, WA, March 5 – In April, 2007, Seattle-based Trans Marine Propulsion Systems, Inc. (TMPS) plans to open a second service and sales facility in Tampa, Florida, giving added convenience to ship owners, offshore operators, power plants, mechanical industries, and ship and engine builders in all parts of the world. The new facility will operate as a subsidiary called Trans Marine Tampa (TMT).

At the new Tampa facility, "Technicians will be on call twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week," says Herbert Roeser, chairman and owner of TMPS. "We have always had people on call at all hours, but they were stationed on the West Coast." The decision to expand came as a result of customer demand. "We have been servicing more and more vessels in the Gulf area, and it was time to set up shop there."

TMPS has found a location in Tampa and plans to start operating there by the end of next month. "We can service most makes and types of diesel engines, including medium-speed and slow-speed engines for the marine industry and for diesel power plants," says Shane Roeser (son of Herbert Roeser), TMPS's Vice President. "We are one of the world's few service facilities that offers this range of experience."
